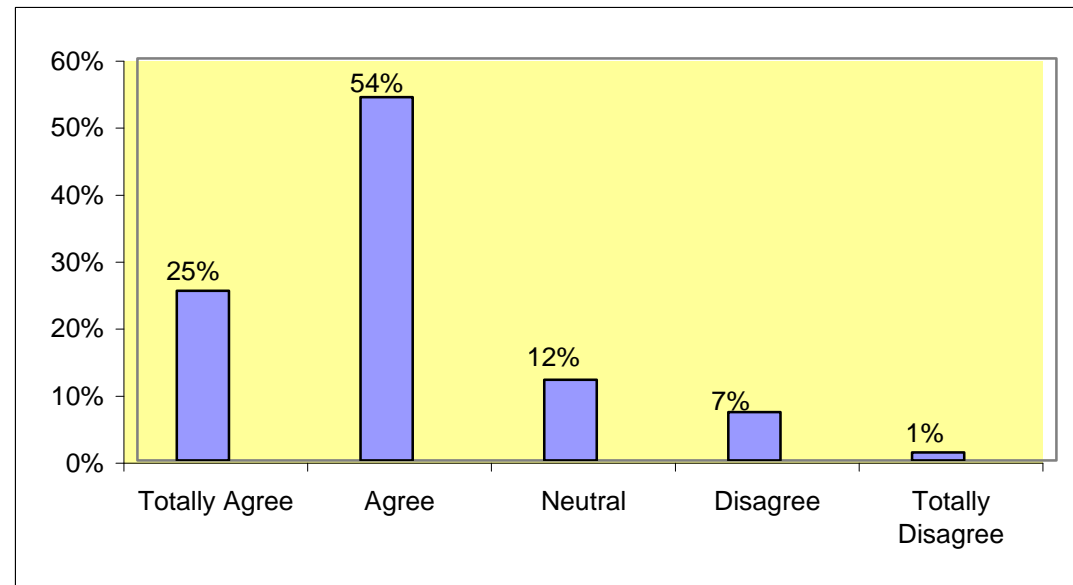

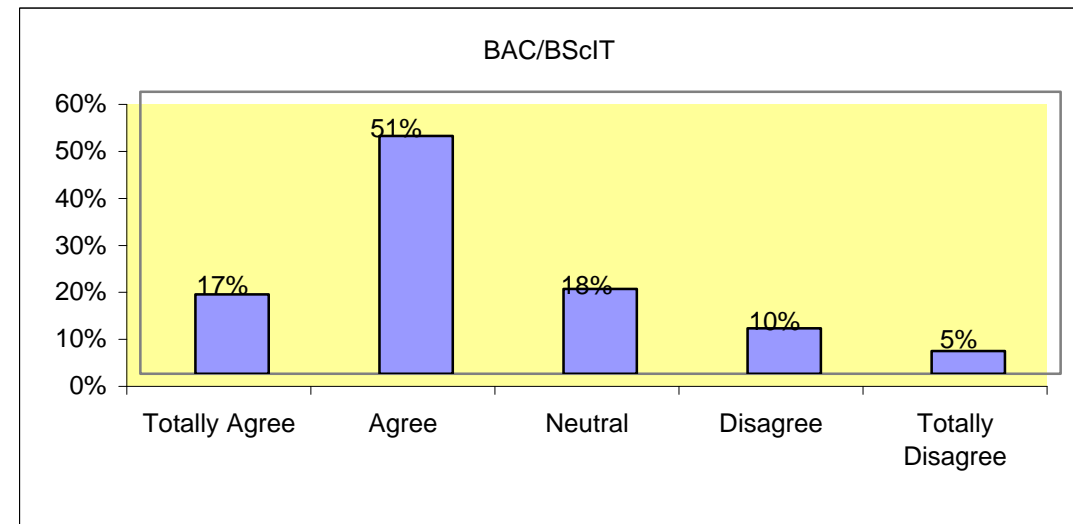
Question 1 : Your overall industrial placement experience is useful to you.

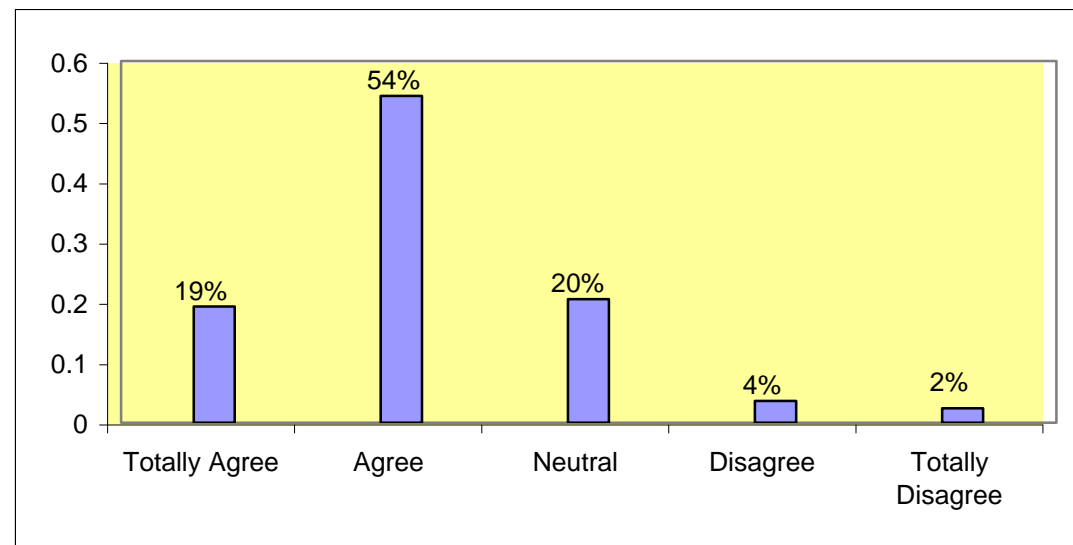
Question 2 : You learned new and important technical skills during your placement training.

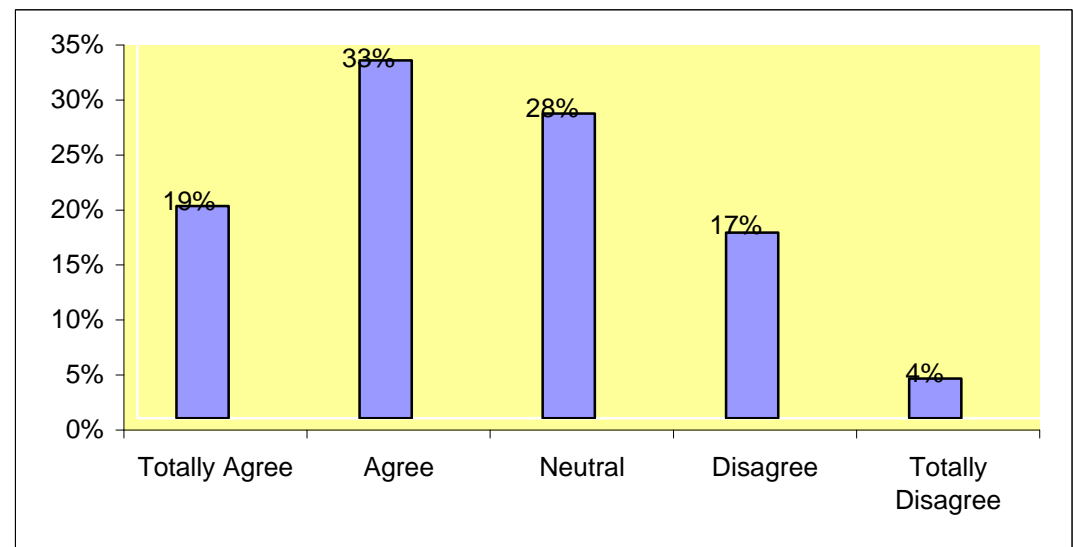
Question 3 : You learned important nontechnical skills, such as communications skill, team work, time management, etc.

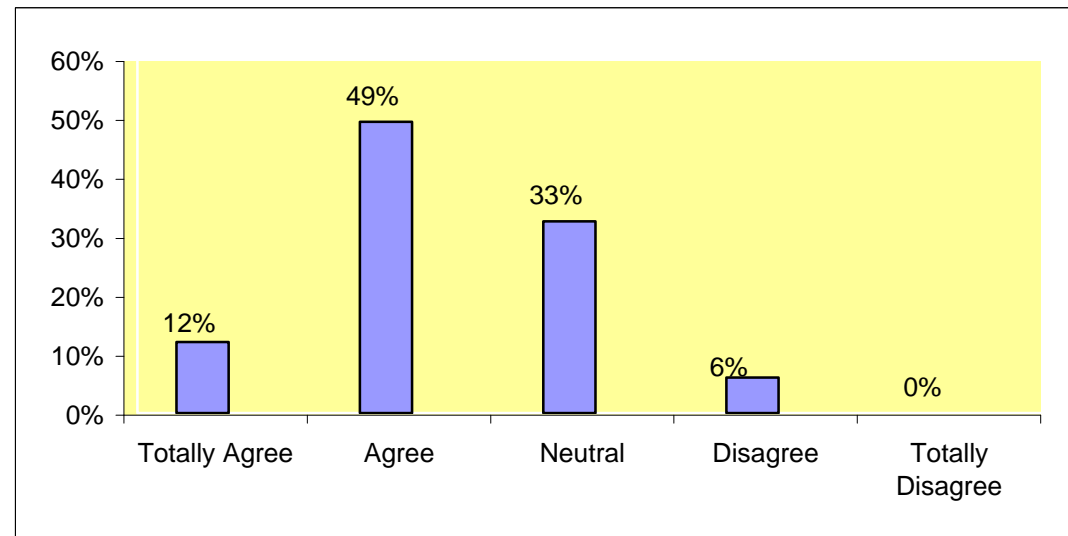

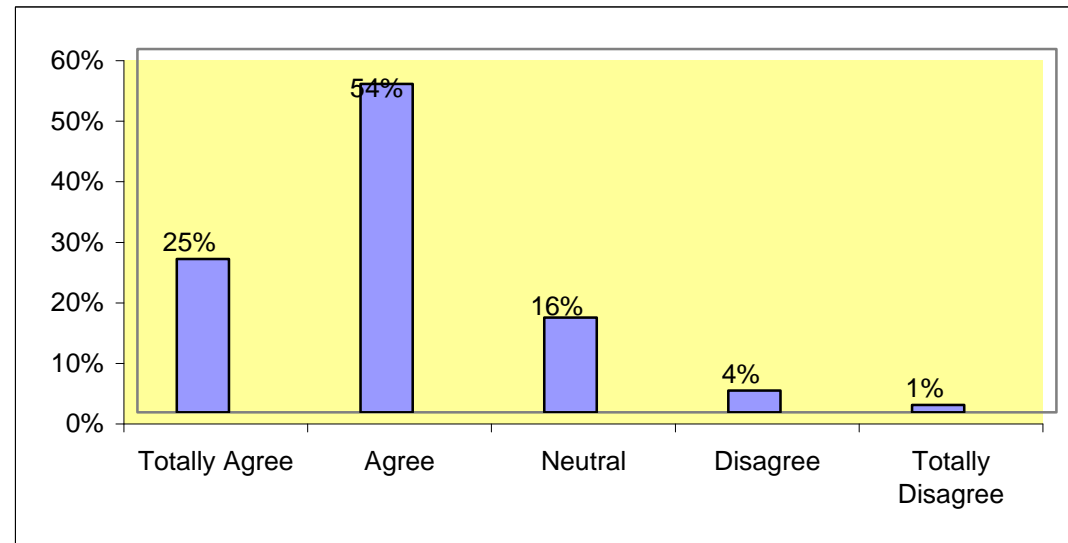
Question 5 : Your placement training helps you decide what you want to do with your future career.

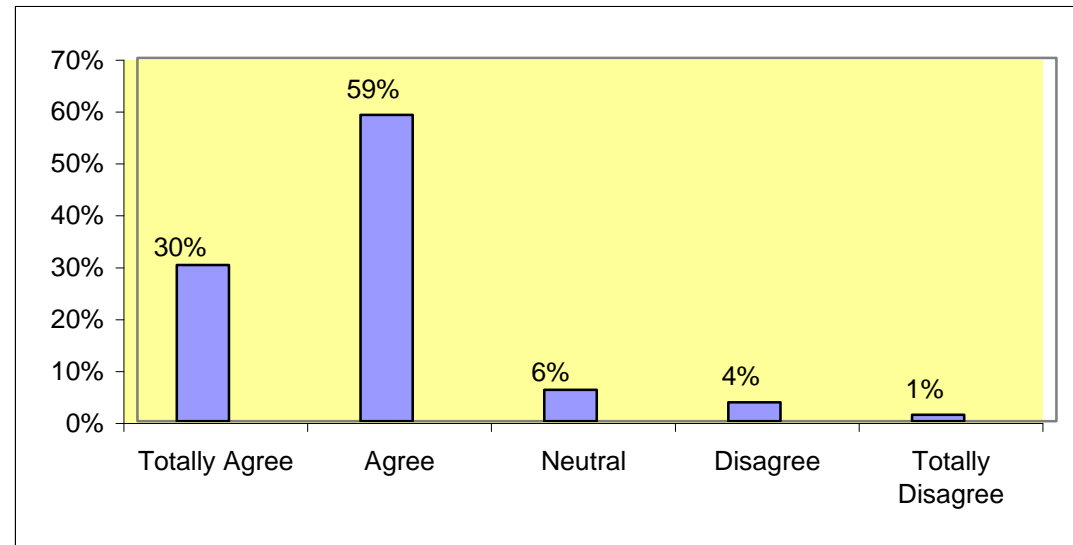
Question 6 : You maintained a good relationship with your supervisors at work.

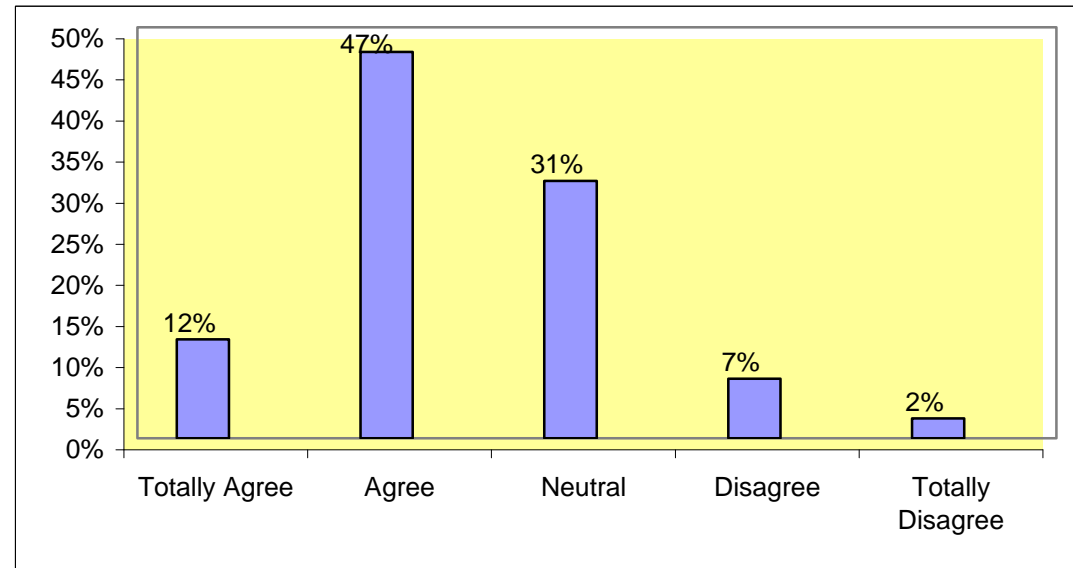
Question 7 : You maintained a good relationship with your peer colleagues at work.

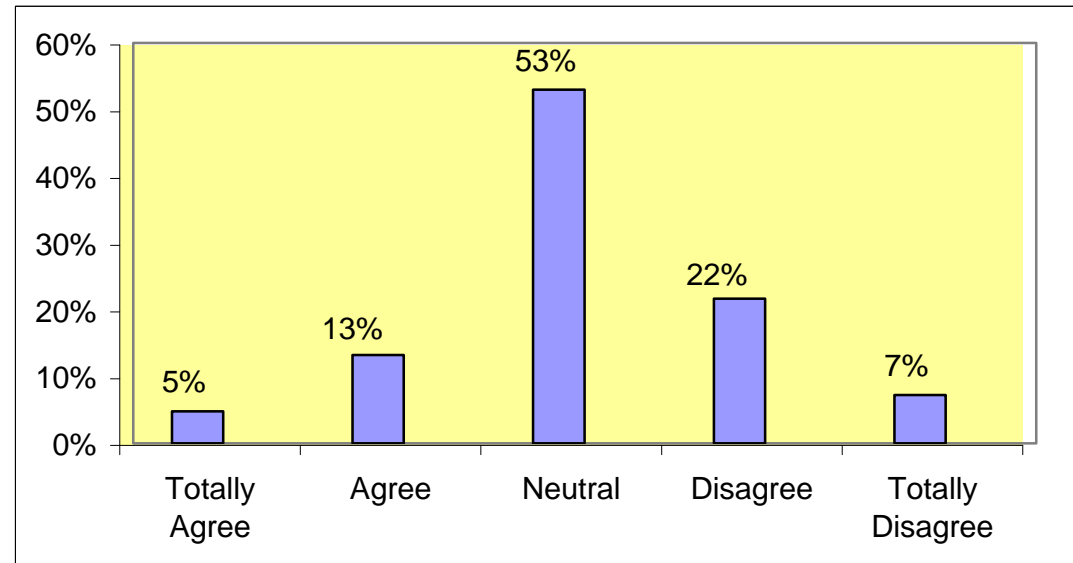
Question 8 : You maintained a good relationship with your clients at work.

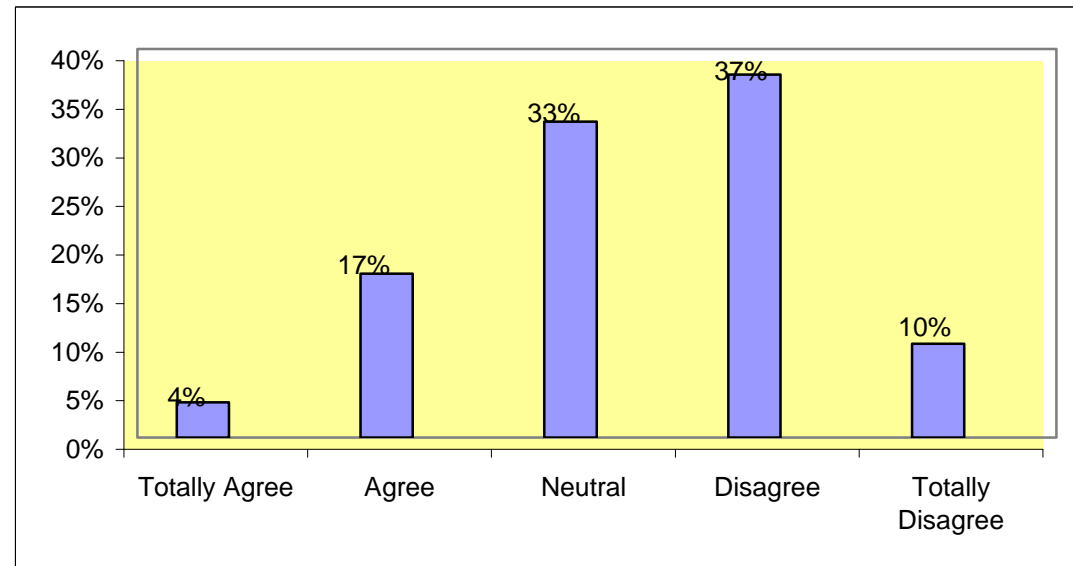
Question 9 : Your supervisors at work would like to hire you back after graduation.

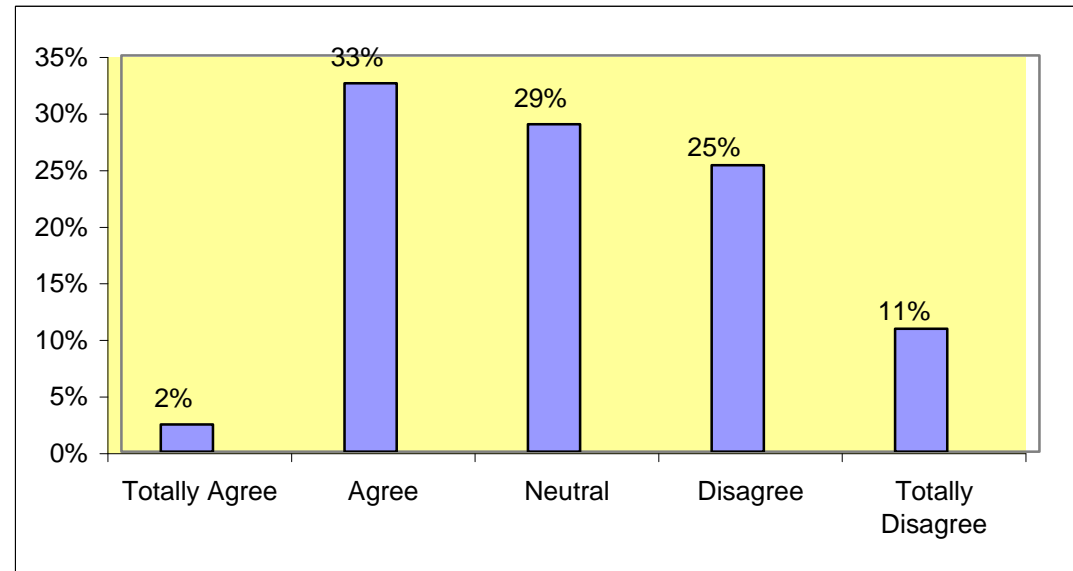
Question 10 : You learned most of the technical skills required for your placement position just before starting your placement.

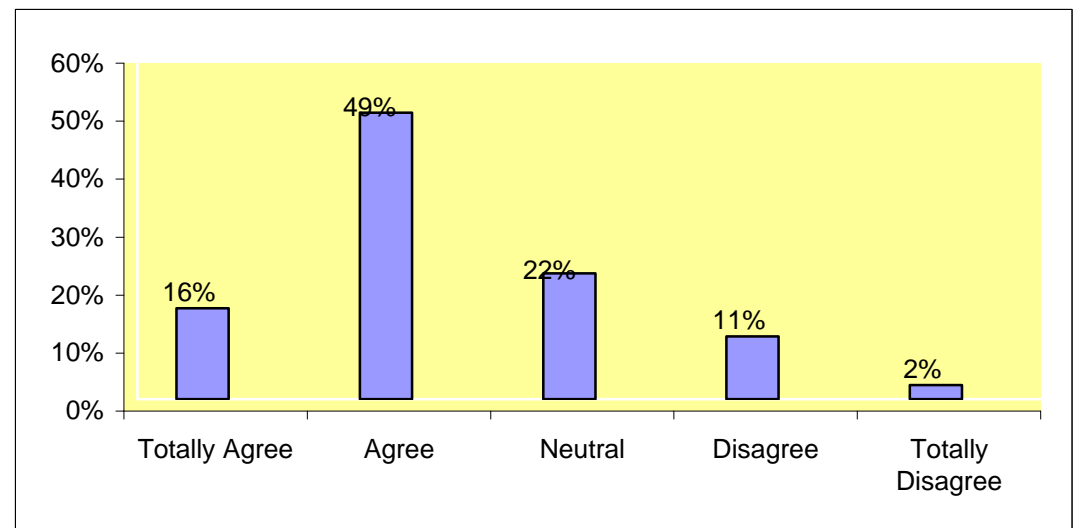
Question 11 : Your first two years of education helped you pick up new technologies and technical skills required for your placement position.

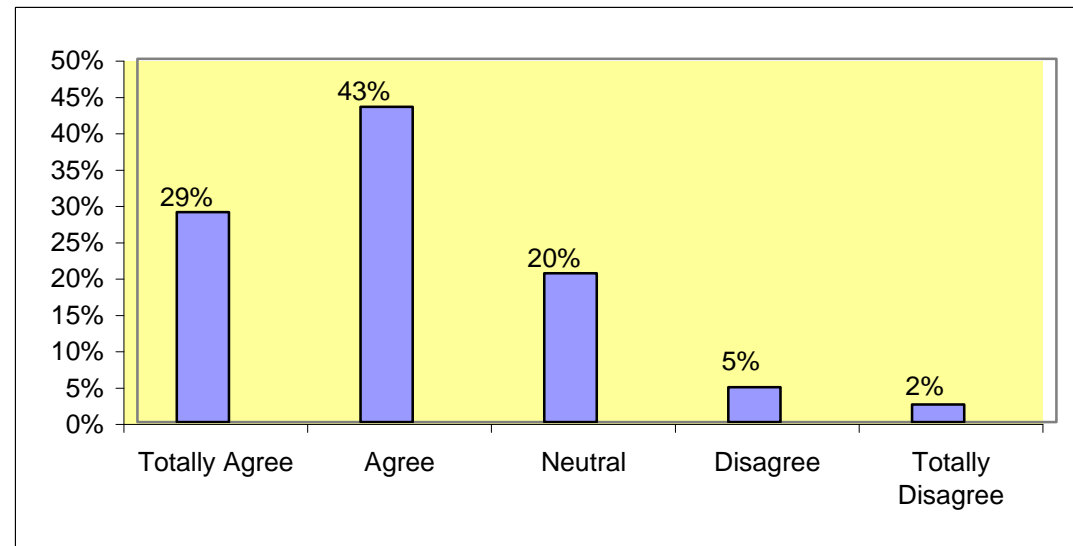

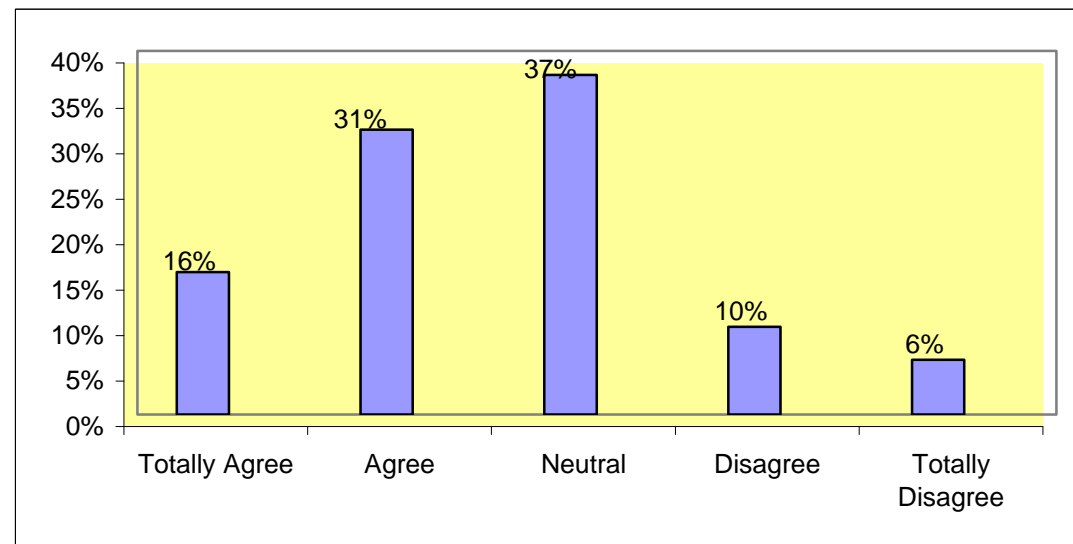
