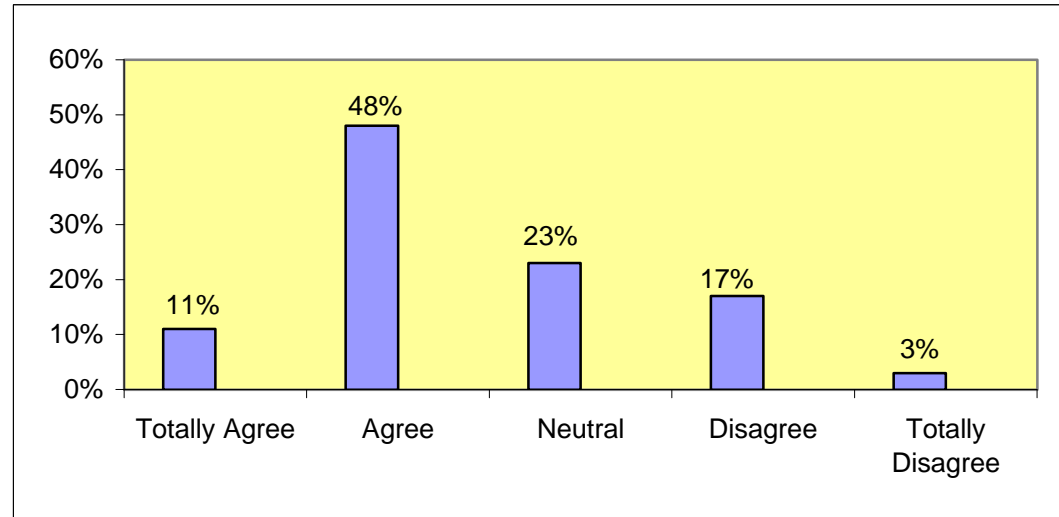


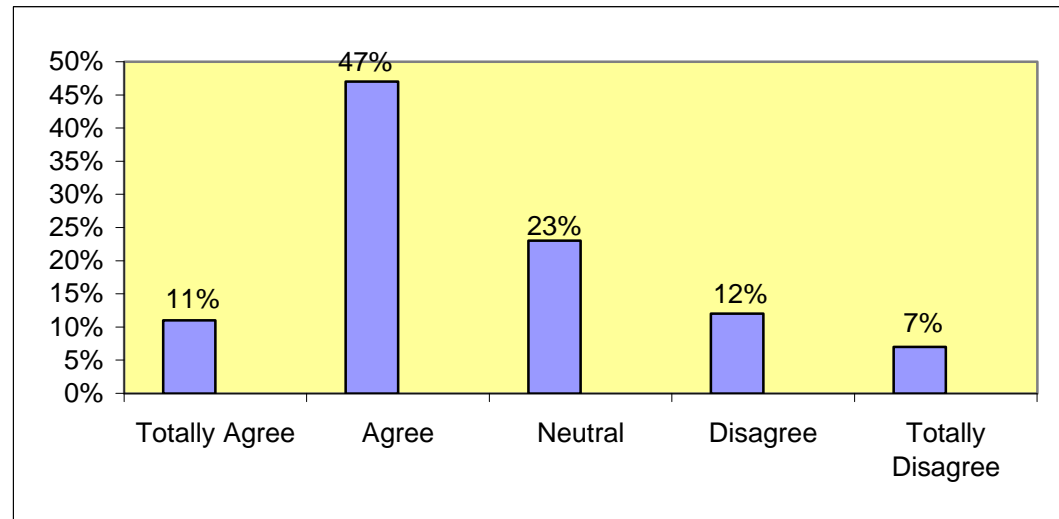
Question 1 : Your overall industrial placement experience is useful to you

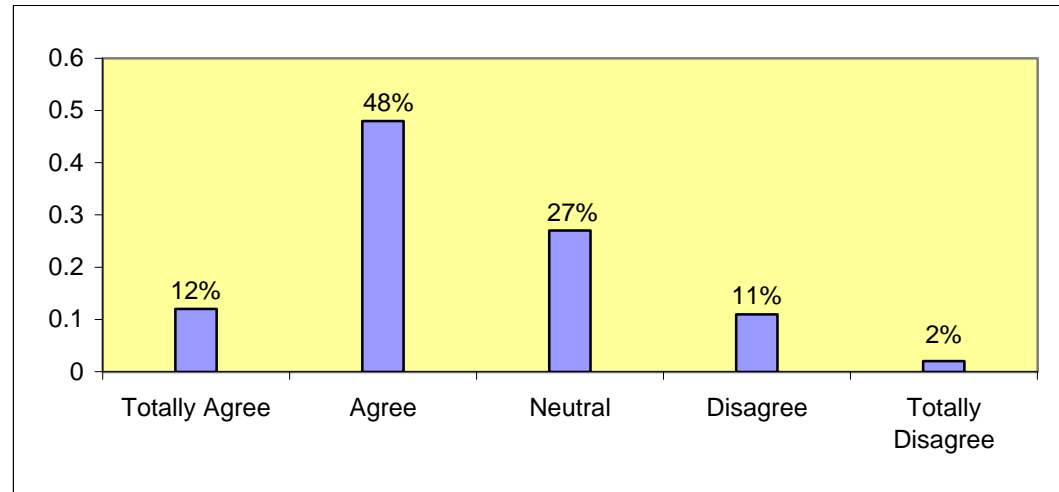
Question 2 : You learned new and important technical skills during your placement training

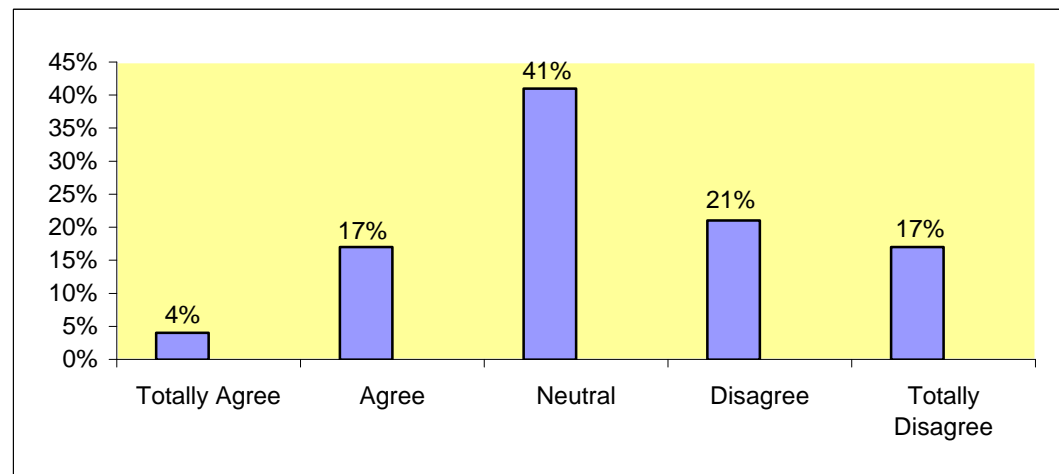
Question 3 : You learned important nontechnical skills, such as communications skill, team work, time management, etc.

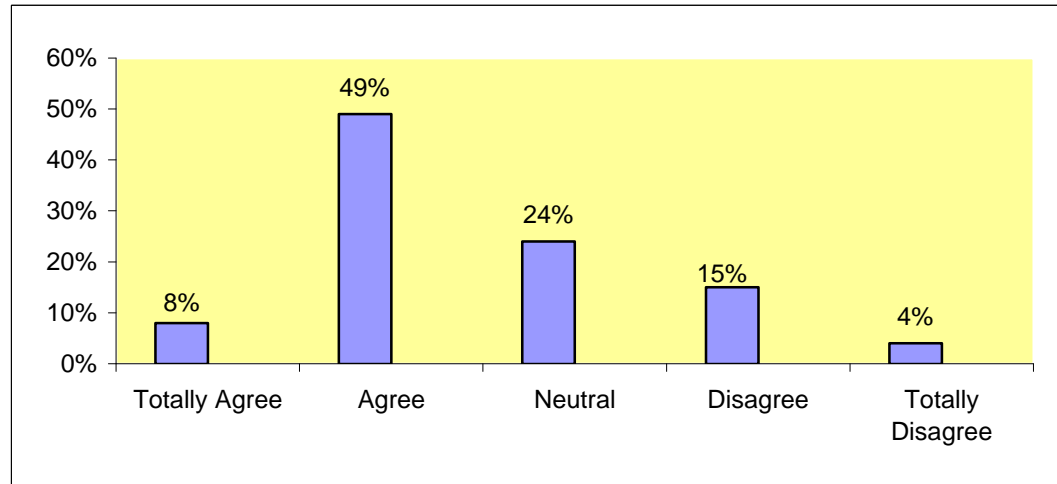
Question 4 : You would like to work for the same placement company (may be a different group) after graduation

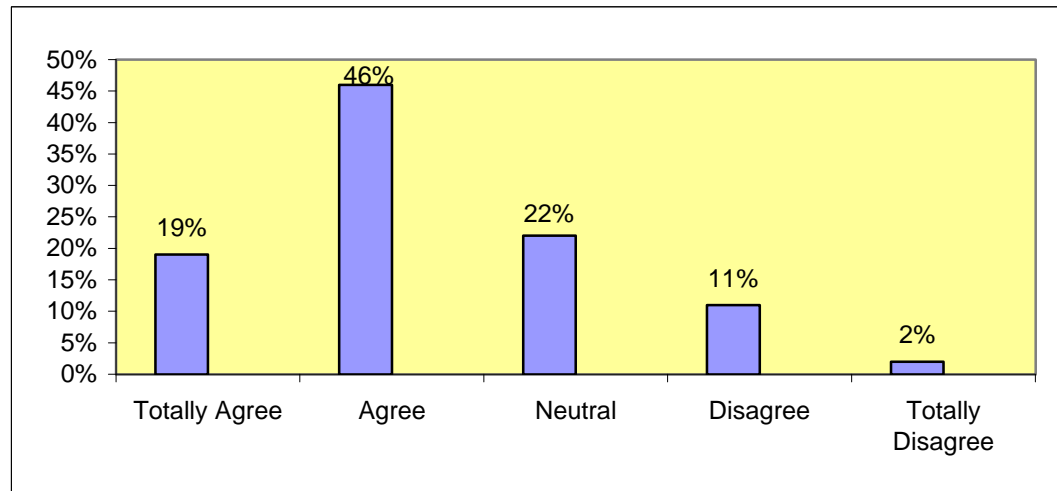
Question 5 : Your placement training helps you decide what you want to do with your future career

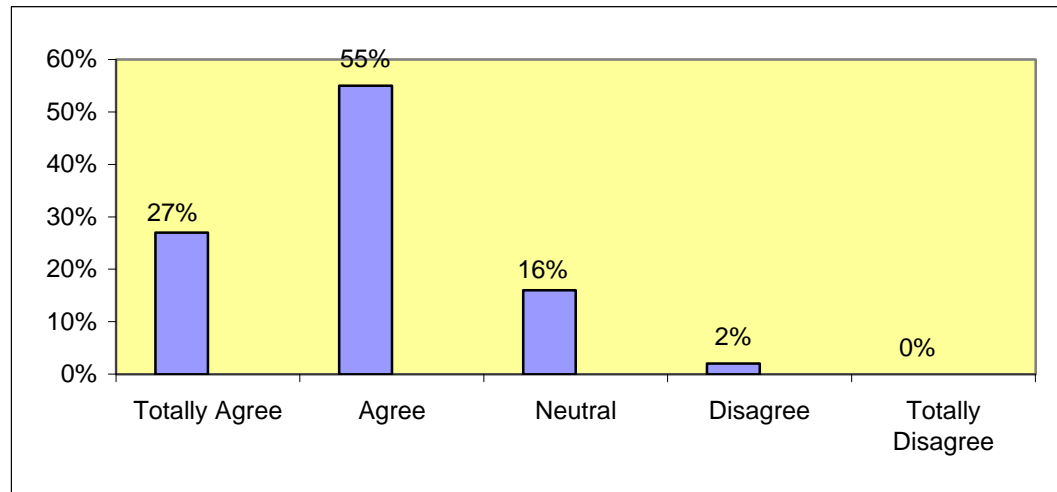
Question 6 : You maintained a good relationship with your supervisors at work

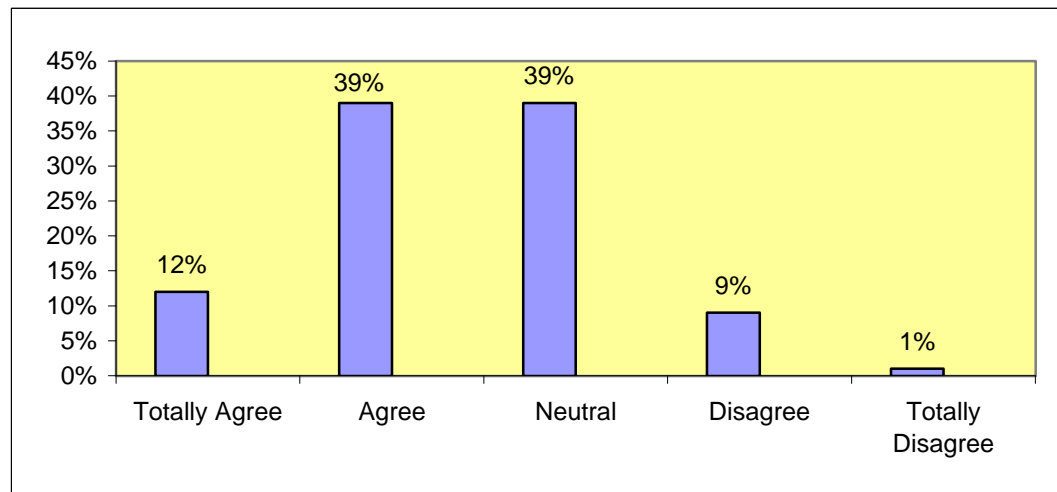
Question 7 : You maintained a good relationship with your peer colleagues at work

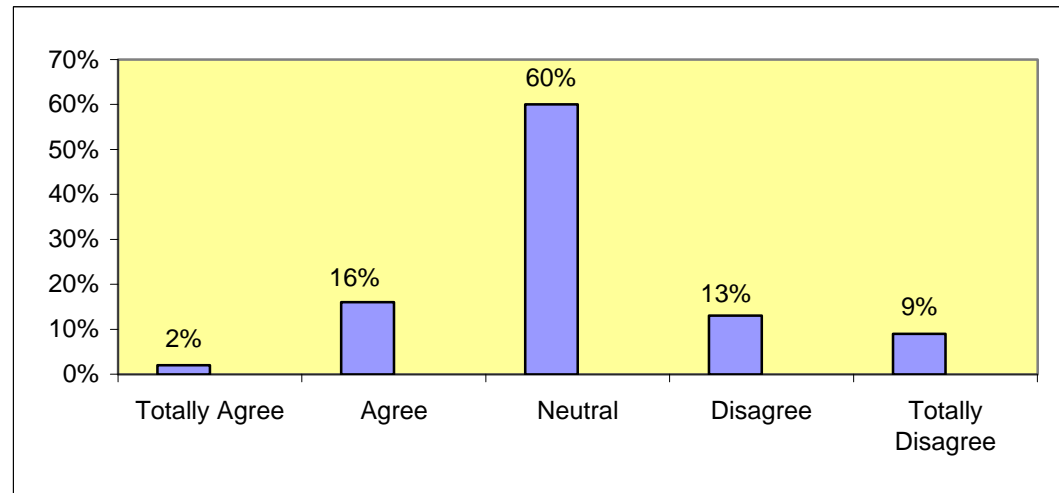
Question 8 : You maintained a good relationship with your clients at work

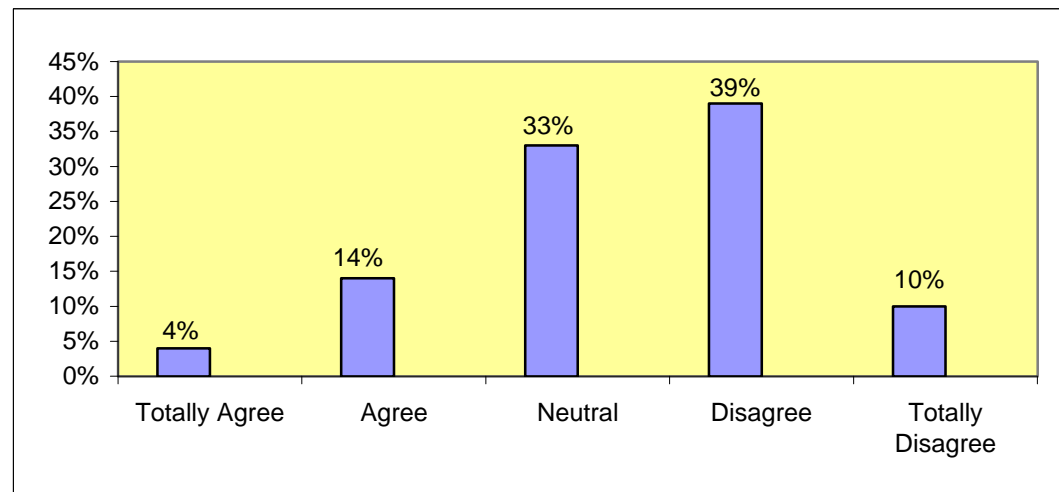
Question 9 : Your supervisors at work would like to hire you back after graduation

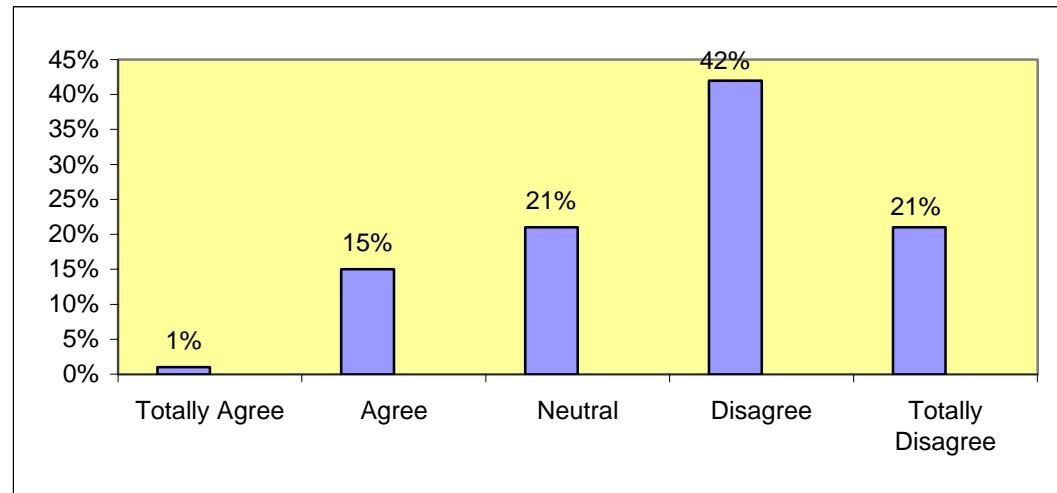
Question 10 : You learned most of the technical skills required for your placement position just before starting your placement

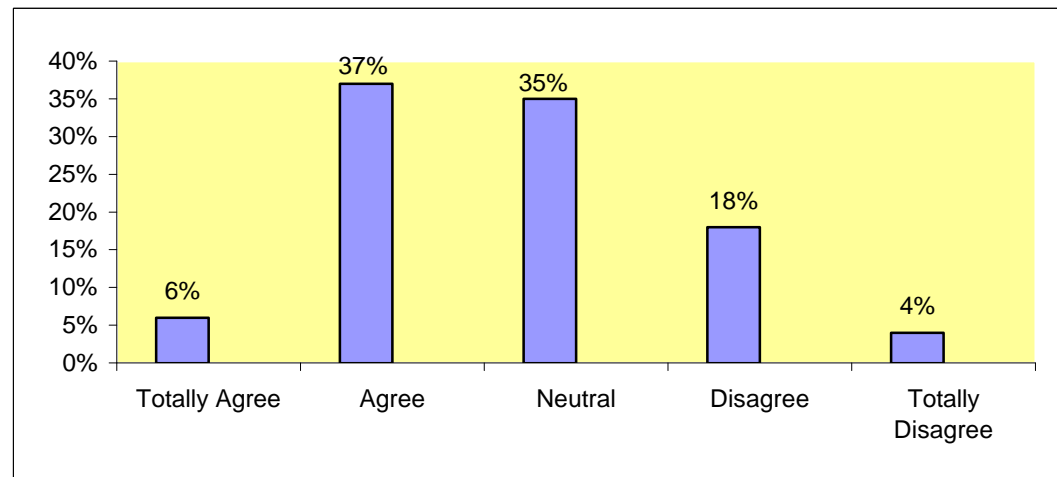
Question 11 : Your first two years of education helped you pick up new technologies and technical skills required for your placement position

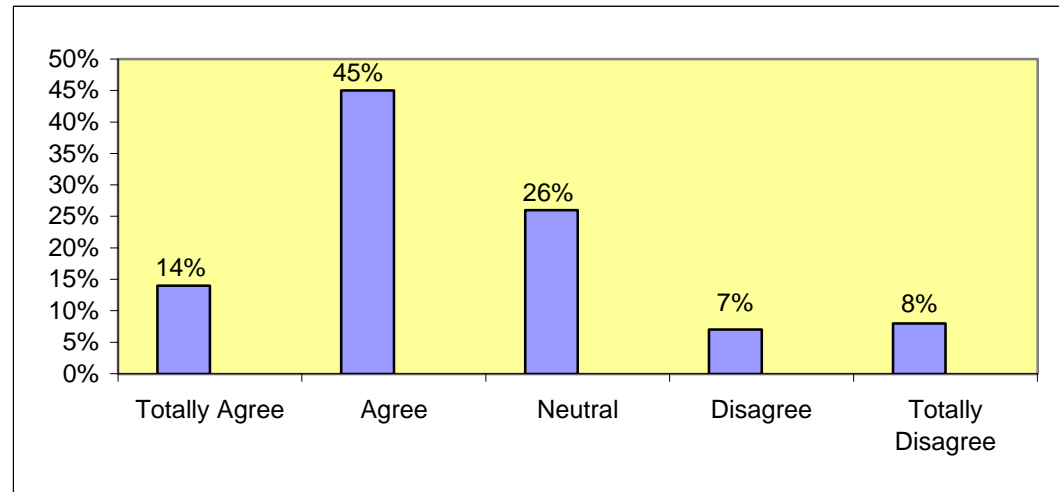
Question 12 : You were able to pick up the technical skills required for your placement position within the first two months of employment

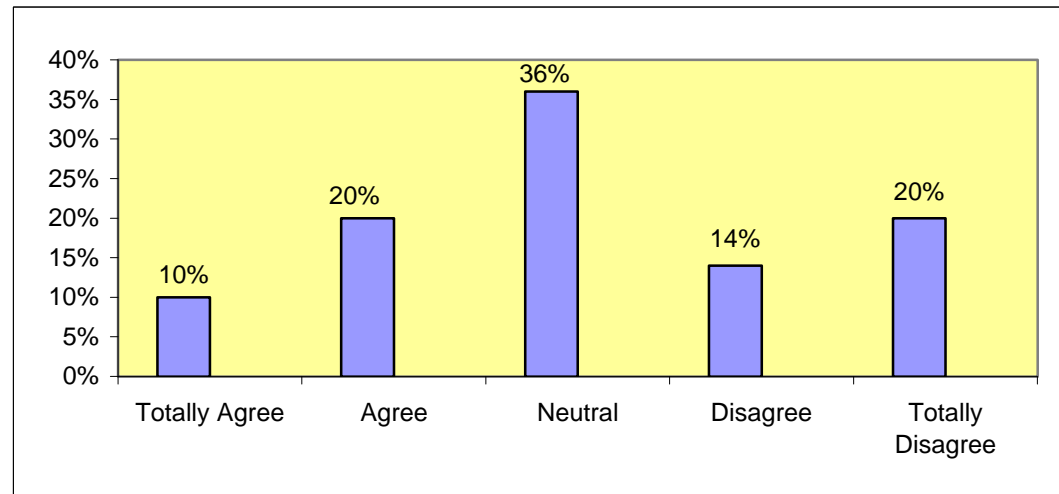
Question 13 : You would recommend the industrial placement program to the current year-two students.

What do you like the most regarding your placement training?

- ◆ **Learnt non-technical skills such as client-servicing techniques, inter-personal communication skills**
- ◆ **Acquired new technological ideas**
- ◆ **Able to accumulate practical working experience**
- ◆ **Good relationship with colleagues**
- ◆ Participating in teamwork
- ◆ Help to identify future career goals

What do you dislike the most regarding your placement training?

- ◆ **Have to do non-IT related jobs, such as working on documentation, secretarial & administrative jobs**
- ◆ Insufficient training provided by the placement companies
- ◆ **Be assigned basic word-processing duties**
- ◆ Poor resources provided
- ◆ Extensive overtime

Other comments and suggestions to improve the placement program

- ◆ **No school fee should be collected during the placement year**
- ◆ **To provide relevant, clearer and more detailed job descriptions beforehand**
- ◆ **More communication channels be opened to placement students to express their feedback**
- ◆ Supply previous placement record for students' reference
- ◆ Department to help investigate the job nature of the company and keep checking the experience of placement students
- ◆ Organize some workshops or talks regarding the ways in selecting a placement company
- ◆ More regular meetings with supervisors
- ◆ To ask for a higher salary scale
