The 2014 International Joint Conference on Biometrics (IJCB 2014) is a special combination of two major biometrics research conferences, the *Biometrics Theory*, *Applications and Systems (BTAS)* conference and the International Conference on Biometrics (ICB). Experimental results for contributions in established areas such as voice, face, iris, fingerprint, and gait are encouraged to use the largest and most challenging existing publicly available datasets. Papers examining the usability of and social impact of biometrics technology are encouraged.
