Electronic submission through the submission website is strongly encouraged. Submission of a paper should be regarded as an undertaking that, should the paper be accepted, at least one of the authors will register and attend the conference to present the work.

PROCEEDINGS

The conference proceedings will be published as Springer-LNCS series (pending) and distributed at the conference. One Best Paper and one Best Student Paper will be selected for awards. Each winner will be presented at the conference with a certificate and US\$100.
